The Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 will conduct a Special Meeting on September 16, 2025 at the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 office located at 8275 FM 78, Suite 2, Converse, Texas 78109 and the following will be discussed;

1. Call the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 Meeting to Order and establish a quorum.
 - a. Pledge of Allegiance.

2. **Public Hearing.**
 - a. The Board President will open the Public Hearing to the citizenry so that they may have an opportunity to express their views on a proposal to increase property taxes within the District. The proposed 2025 Tax Rate is \$ 0.10 per \$ 100 property valuation. (3-minute time limit per individual).
 - b. The Board President will close the Public Hearing.

3. Discussion and action on District's 2025 Tax Rate and approval of Order No. 091625-03 to be read as follows:

AN ORDER OF THE BEXAR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 LEVYING THE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2025 TAX YEAR AT A RATE OF \$ 0.10 PER \$ 100 ASSESSED VALUATION ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE LEGALLY ESTABLISHED BOUNDARIES OF BEXAR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION NEEDS FOR THE 2026 FISCAL YEAR; AND A DEBT RATE OF \$ 0.00 (zero) PER \$ 100 ASSESSED VALUATION ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE LEGALLY ESTABLISHED BOUNDARIES OF BEXAR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR THE 2026 FISCAL YEAR.

4. Approval to pay the District's bills.

5. Determine date, time and possible agenda items for the next Board meeting.

6. Adjourn.
