

**Bexar County  
Emergency Services District No. 1  
Special Meeting Minutes  
February 19, 2025  
5:30 P.M.**

**The Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 conducted a meeting on February 19, 2025 at the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 office located at 8275 FM 78, Suite 2, Converse, Texas 78109 and the following will be discussed;**

1. Commissioner Ortiz called the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 meeting to Order at 5:30 P.M. and established a quorum with Commissioners' George, Galindo and Murphy.
2. Citizens Forum (3-minute time limit per individual). No citizens signed up to speak at this time.
3. **Chief's Report.**
  - a. Run Report. The Fire Department responded to 552 calls for the month of January. Out of that 237 were for the District. Total of 12 structure fires with 5 in the District.
  - b. Events. The Fire Department held its annual awards gala which was huge success. The Department will be hosting a National Day of Prayer on Thursday, May 1<sup>st</sup>.
4. Discussion and action on presentation by the City of Converse on contractual discussions, ISO rating and related matters with questions and answers between District Commissioners, representatives of the City of Converse, and representatives of Insurance Services Office, Inc.(ISO). City Manager Lambert informed the Board about rising cost related to the services that it provides to the District.

The ISO representative spoke to the Board about the excellent rating that the City has earned. The excellent rating has expanded to the District and has helped the residents of the District lower the comprehensive portion of their home insurance.

The City stated that they would want to continue providing fire extinguishment and first responder services. The City is asking that the District consider providing more funds for these services. At this time the City requested that the District consider their request as it prepares for negotiations for the upcoming contract agreement.
