

Bexar County

Special Meeting Minutes
September 16, 2025
5:30 P.M.

The Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 conducted a Special Meeting on September 16, 2025 at the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 office located at 8275 FM 78, Suite 2, Converse, Texas 78109 and the following was discussed;

1. Commissioner George called the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 Meeting to Order at 5:30 P.M. and established a quorum with Commissioners' Galindo and Murphy. Commissioner Ortiz was unable to attend.
 - a. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

2. **Public Hearing.**
 - a. The Board President will open the Public Hearing to the citizenry so that they may have an opportunity to express their views on a proposal to increase property taxes within the District. The proposed 2025 Tax Rate is \$ 0.10 per \$ 100 property valuation. (3-minute time limit per individual). Commissioner George opened the Public Hearing at 5:31 P.M. to the citizenry. No one signed up to speak at the Hearing.
 - b. The Board President will close the Public Hearing. Commissioner George closed the Hearing at 5:46 P.M.

3. Discussion and action on District's 2025 Tax Rate and approval of Order No. 091625-03 to be read as follows:

AN ORDER OF THE BEXAR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 LEVYING THE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2025 TAX YEAR AT A RATE OF \$ 0.10 PER \$ 100 ASSESSED VALUATION ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE LEGALLY ESTABLISHED BOUNDARIES OF BEXAR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION NEEDS FOR THE 2026 FISCAL YEAR; AND A DEBT RATE OF \$ 0.00 (zero) PER \$ 100 ASSESSED VALUATION ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE LEGALLY ESTABLISHED BOUNDARIES OF BEXAR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR THE 2026 FISCAL YEAR. Commissioner Galindo made a motion to approve the 2025 Tax Rate as proposed and approve the Order. Commissioner Murphy seconded the motion. Motion carried by a 3/0 vote.

4. Approval to pay the District's bills. Commissioner Murphy made a motion to approve the

District's bills. Commissioner Galindo seconded the motion. Motion carried by a 3/0 vote.

5. Determine date, time and possible agenda items for the next Board meeting. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for October 14, 2025 at 5:30 P.M.
6. Adjourn. With no further business before the Board Commissioner Galindo made a motion to adjourn at 5:51 P.M. Commissioner George seconded the motion. Motion carried by a 3/0 vote.
