

**Bexar County
Emergency Services District No. 1
Meeting Minutes
June 9, 2026
5:30 P.M.**

The Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 conducted a meeting on June 9, 2026 at the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 office located at 8275 FM 78, Suite 2, Converse, Texas 78109 and the following was discussed;

1. Commissioner Ortiz called the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 1 Meeting to Order at 5:31 P.M. and established a quorum with Commissioners' Murphy, Galindo and George.
2. Citizens Forum (3-minute time limit per individual). No one signed to speak.
3. Discussion on an overpayment made to the City of Converse for fire suppression services and action to recover it. The City concurred with the amount in question and requested that it be deducted from their final quarter payment.
4. **Chief's Report.**
 - a. Run Report. For the month there were 437 calls with 135 in the District. None of these calls were for structure fires.
 - b. Events. The Fire Department is currently preparing for its upcoming summer camp program
5. Update on potential property for the District's office. Commissioner Ortiz gave a brief updated summary of what has happen within the last 30 days.
6. **Financial Reports.**
 - a. Review of the Financial Reports for the District. The Board reviewed the Financials.
 - b. Approval to pay the bills for the District. All invoices were reviewed, Commissioner Galindo made motion to approve payment of the bills for the District. Commissioner George seconded the motion. Motion carried by a 4/0 vote.
7. Determine date, time and possible agenda items for the next Board meeting. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for June 18, 2026 at 5:30 P.M.
8. Adjourn. Commissioner Galindo made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner .

Murphy seconded the motion. Motion carried by a 4/0 vote, With no further business to discuss, Commissioner Ortiz adjourned the meeting at 5:52 P.M.
